Article 1 **Object of Provision**

According to Article 4 paragraph 7 of the Organization Regulations of Masaryk University and in accordance with the MU Statutes I issue this provision, which specifies courses that can be passed by FI doctoral students repeatedly.

 - Computer Graphics and Image Processing
 - Computer Networks Methods
 - Digital Data Processing Methods
 - Enterprise IT Systems and Services
 - Advanced Methods for Natural Language Processing and Artificial Intelligence
 - Advances in Concurrency
 - Research Project in Computer Security
 - External Course
 - Lecture of Foreign Expert
 - Working Seminar on Formal Models, Discrete Structures and Algorithms
