Thinking about moving to Brno and working at Faculty of Informatics (FI), Masaryk University? Here you can find some useful information.

The charming capital of Moravia lies only two hours of drive from Prague or Vienna. With its 6 universities Brno is a scientific and cultural center of the region. This lively town with cozy pubs and quality restaurants is well known for its cheap but high quality beers and wines. But there is more to Brno than just a pulsing downtown. Due to its long history it features many tourist attractions such as the Church of St. Peter, the Spilberk Castle or the famous Villa of Tugendhat the UNESCO jewel of functionalism.



40 thousand students make Masaryk University the second largest and most demanded university in the Czech Republic. The Faculty of Informatics (FI) is located in a quiet neighborhood close to the city center. Its research attracts the internationally attention and allures foreign scientists to Brno.
